CALL FOR PAPERS CIGRÉ Colloquium on: Large Electrical Machines and Renewable Generation

Topics:

- 1. Operation of large electrical machines connected to an electrical network: grid codes, standards, diagrams of operation, overfluxing, excitation systems, torsional eletromechanical oscillations, etc.;
- 2. Assessment of the large electrical machines state: criteria, risk management, retrofit, replacement, power up- rating, efficiency improvement and methods for predicting the remaining life of aged generators;
- 3. Specific problems of wind generators: testing commissioning, operation modes, network integration, etc.;
- 4. Pumped Storage Power Plants;
- 5. Control, efficiency and operation of large motors in power plants;
- 6. Experience in monitoring, diagnosis, prognosis and maintenance in electrical rotating machines.

Participation fee for Colloquium

The registration of **all A1 members** including chairman, secretary, advisory, regular members, observer members and WG/AG conveners, is **free of charge**.

TECHNICAL VISIT

An optional Technical visit to the **Vidraru Hydro Power Plant and Dam** has been also scheduled. **The Vidraru Dam is considered by specialists a real jewelry of engineering.**

Situated at 170 km (106 miles) from Bucharest, the <u>Vidraru Hydro Power Plant</u> is equipped with four 50 MW hydrogenerators. The power plant has been built 104 m under the ground. The dam is 166.6 m high and is a double arc. It is situated 6 km from the Power Plant on the **Transfagarasan Road**.

The <u>Transfagarasan Road</u> is the road that crosses the Fagaras mountains between Wallachia and Transylvania, at an altitude of up to 2034 m.

The distance from the Vidraru Hydro Power Plant to the **Glacial Hollow Balea**. is of 65 km (40 miles) . The participants will have lunch at the Balea Lake Chalet (2034 m).

Participation fee

The price of the Technical Visit for all the participants/companions is **Euro 100/person**, or the equivalent amount in RON. The participants will receive a receipt.
